The project should consist of a vertical, horizontal or inclined transportation system of an innovative design, special application or approach that has solved a major problem or overcome a unique challenge.

All entries will be judged as received by a distinguished panel of industry specialists who are viewed by their peers and have proven by their accomplishments to be experts in the field of vertical and horizontal transportation, and building planning and design.

Projects will be judged on the following: innovation, originality and creativity, challenges overcome, installation methods and techniques, and the use of advanced technology. The overall quality of the presentation will account for part of the score.

Winning entries will be published in the January 2010 issue of ELEVATOR WORLD, and the winners in each category will be acknowledged with an award of recognition.

Awards Contest

Rules & Requirements:

1. Contest entry period begins June 1, 2009 and ends August 31, 2009.
2. The transportation-system portion of the project must have been completed within two years of the contest entry period. Incomplete projects and previously submitted Project of the Year entries are not eligible.
3. Entries must include the required entry materials as listed below with 2 bound hard-copies and 1 CD that includes both text and photos.

For each entry, fill out this form (or a copy), and attach it to the front cover of your entry. Include the following materials:

- ◆ a one-page description of the entire project;
- ◆ a one- to five-page description of the transportation system, providing the project details, transportation-system outline specifications and why the project should be considered for an award;
- ◆ a list of credits, citing building owner, developer, architect, designer, planner, transportation-systems contractor, equipment manufacturer(s), component supplier(s), consultant(s) and other pertinent project participants (companies only). Be sure to include the contact person's name, company name, address and phone number; and
- ◆ at least six high-resolution color photographs that capture the major aspects of the project, with particular emphasis on the transportation system and brief descriptions of each aspect.

4. All submissions will become property of ELEVATOR WORLD and must be accompanied by the project owner's permission for ELEVATOR WORLD to run the submission as a feature story in ELEVATOR WORLD.
5. ELEVATOR WORLD reserves the right to accept or reject any submissions for not complying with the contest rules or not meeting the spirit of the **ELEVATOR WORLD Project of the Year** contest.
6. All employees of ELEVATOR WORLD and their families are ineligible to participate.
